Purpose

Informal camping is enjoyed by a wide spectrum of people along quiet roadsides, loch shores and river banks. This workshop will share experiences of management options, awareness-raising messages and communication methods aimed at campers who are neglecting their responsibilities. The focus will be on how to target small informal groups who go social camping mainly congregating to drink and party. It will consider communication techniques and recreation management principles which may provide effective visitor management solutions.

Who is it for?

This workshop is for rangers, site managers, wardens and land managers who are experiencing camping related problems and issues.

Content

There is evidence that a few users may be claiming access rights in defence of

unacceptable behaviour and, by implication, overlooking their responsibilities. This workshop will examine commonly reported problems including litter, pollution, toilet sanitation, vandalism and fires. It will help you to identify the management options to consider and the management actions and approaches taken elsewhere.
