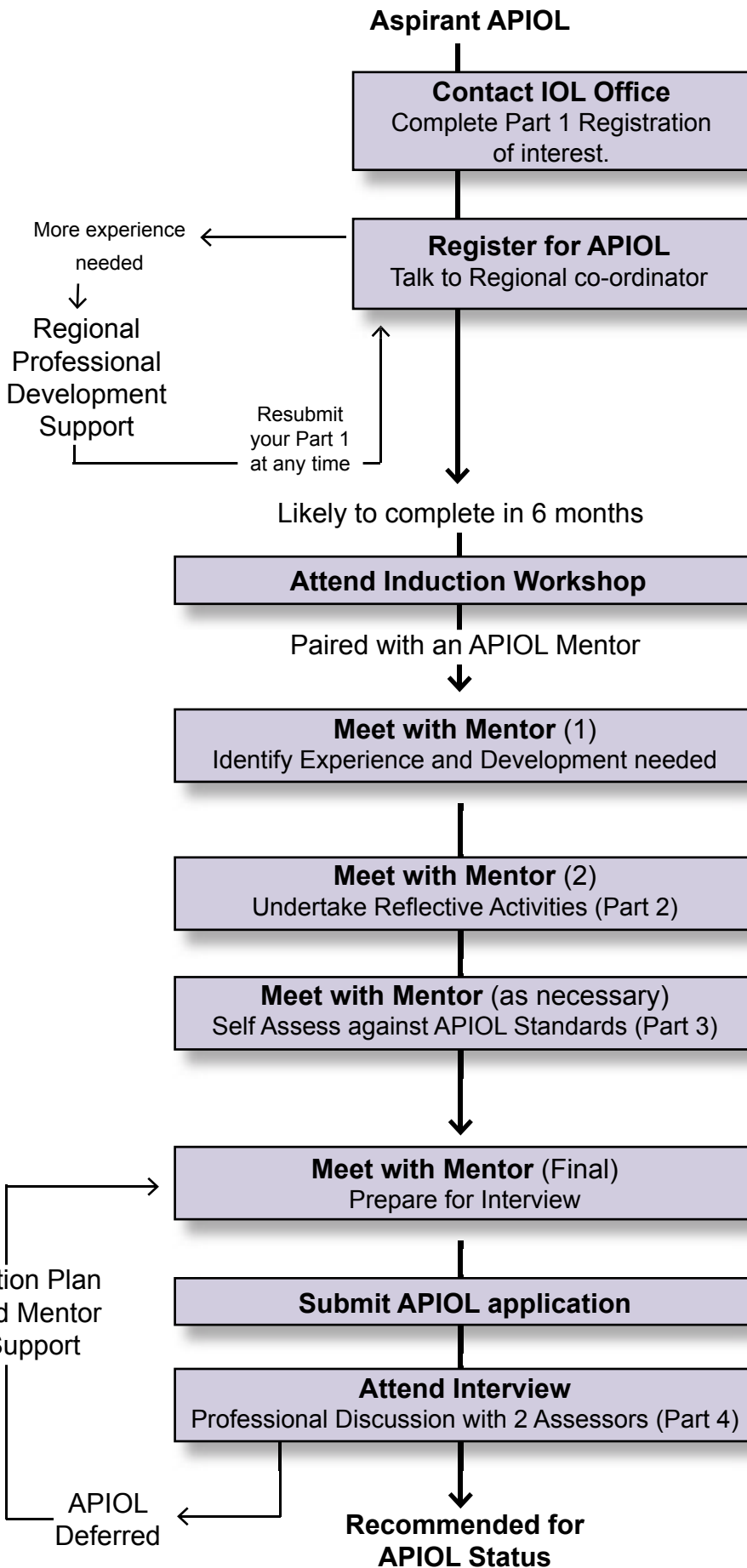
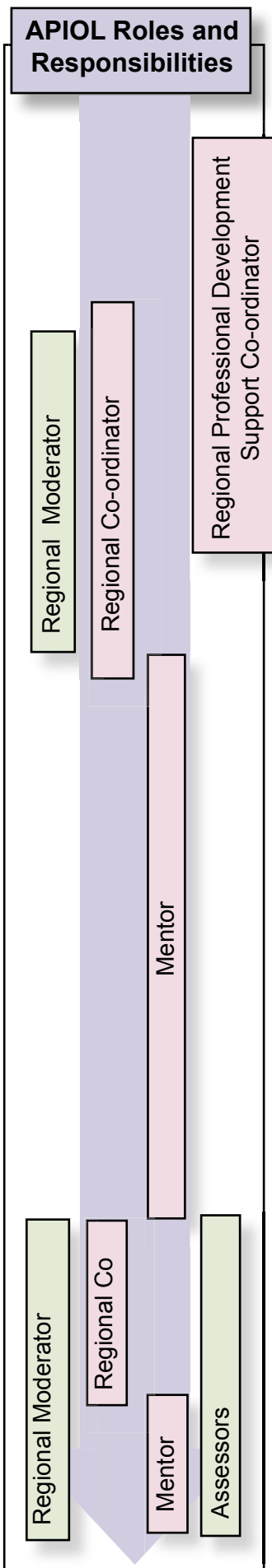
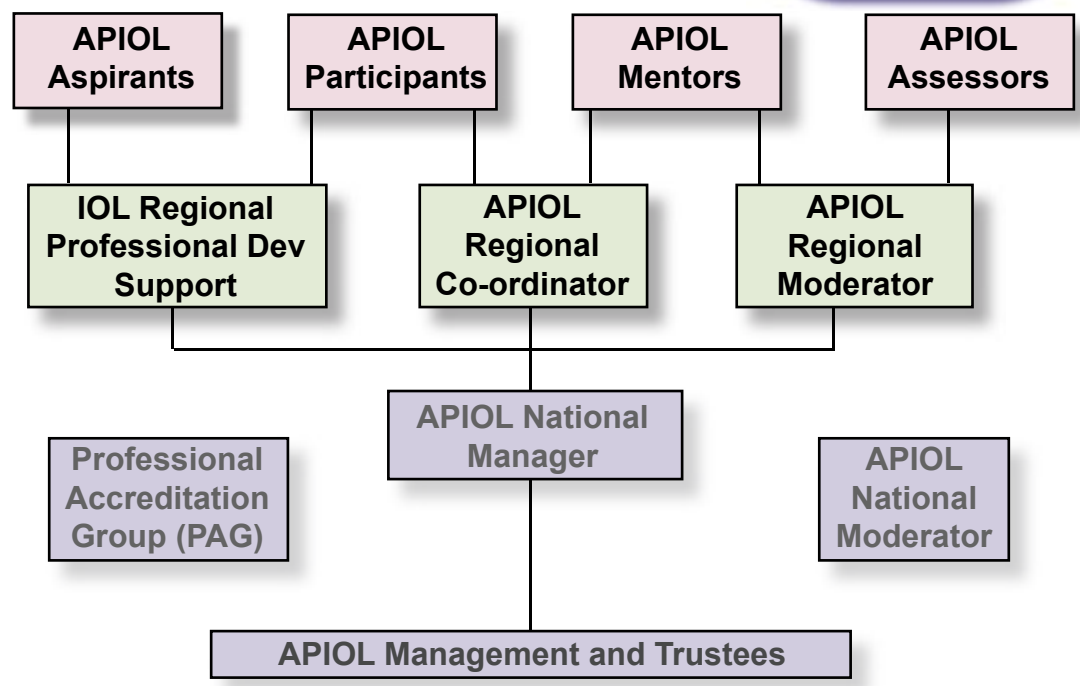

Aspirants – have expressed an interest and are working to acquire the pre-requisite experience

Participants – have the prerequisite experience to meet the benchmarks and complete the APIOL process in 6 months. Prepared to show how they meet the APIOL standards.

Mentors – support Participants through the APIOL process. The key link between the participant and APIOL. Help Participants reflect and self assess against the benchmarks and standards. Encourage further professional development.

Assessors – work in pairs. Facilitate the final Interview involving a Professional Discussion to confirm that the participant meets the APIOL benchmarks and standards. Maintain standards.

Regional Moderator – Approves intake participants and allocation of Mentors with the Regional Co-ordinator. Receives completed APIOL applications. Co-ordinates Interviews: allocates and monitors Assessors. Supervises Deferral Support. Trains and Updates Mentors and Assessors. Liaises with National Moderator.

Professional Accreditation Group – Oversees the development and review of Professional Accreditation for IOL including Accredited Practitioner and Fellow

National Manager – Liaises with Professional Accreditation Group, IOL Management Group and IOL Trustees. Co-ordinates APIOL regional activity. Develops and supports Regional Co-ordinators and Regional Moderators. External Liaison with national qualification bodies

National Moderator – Moderates standards between regions.

Regional Professional Development Support – helps aspirant APIOLs to identify opportunities to acquire the experience they need to meet the benchmarks for APIOL.

Regional Co-ordinator – Co-ordinates Participants interaction with the APIOL process. Introduces Participants into the APIOL ethos and process. Vets applications against Benchmarks with Regional Moderator and refers applicants to Induction day or Professional Development Support. Co-ordinates allocation of Mentors with the Regional Moderator.

IOL Management Group and Trustees – Ensure APIOL is in line with IOL policies and budgets.
