Purpose of the job

The Lead Instructor plays a vital role in delivering UK Youth's mission to make outdoor learning accessible, inspiring, and impactful for all young people. This role supports the design and delivery of high-quality, inclusive, and safe outdoor learning experiences, while also undertaking duty-instructor responsibilities that involve coordinating daily operations, ensuring smooth programme delivery, and providing guidance and motivation to less experienced staff.

As a key member of the delivery team, the Lead Instructor helps maintain Avon Tyrrell's reputation as a respected and professional outdoor centre, strengthening our position as leaders in outdoor learning and youth work by modelling excellence, supporting continuous improvement, and upholding the organisation's core objectives:

- Provide excellent customer care by interacting politely, helpfully, and professionally with all visitors and participants.
- Hold a valid first aid qualification and record all accidents and incidents in accordance with reporting procedures.

- To support local community engagement, helping promote and attend community events to build an understanding of the historical value and learning opportunities available.
- Attend and proactively participate in regular performance reviews and charity meetings as required
- To support on-call duties on a rota basis as required
- To act as a positive ambassador for UK Youth and share knowledge and experience of the development of UK Youth and its profile
- Undertake any other duties and reasonable requests that are in keeping with the nature of this post.
