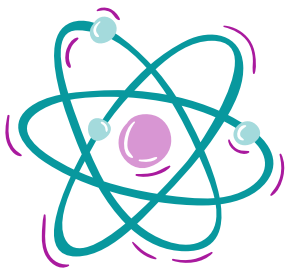


Do you want to promote safety?
